At 1.5 km long, Federsee boardwalk leads through the impenetrable Federsee reed-covered landscape, right into the nature reserve. Discover exciting facts about the flora and fauna of the moor in the guided tours of Federsee NABU conservation centre.

Experience the magical atmosphere of the lake, especially in the morning and in evening. Federsee European Reserve lets you see nature up close: A natural paradise with a unique variety of plant and bird species, such as marsh harriers, bearded tits, meadow pipits, stonechats, water rails ...

Did you know that ... there is a forest in Bad Buchau where you can make the trees move?

Tip Allow 2 hours for your trip on the boardwalk and then a break for refreshments in the city centre.

UNESCO world heritage center Federsee



The Federsee area is a „hotspot“ of archaeological settlement research in Europe and a true treasure trove of Upper Swabian archaeology. The humid bog has acted as the perfect preserving agent - for over millennia. This contributes to the uniqueness and quality of the conservation finds in the Federsee reeds.

Federsee museum with archaeological outdoor area



A new permanent exhibition provides an exclusive „showcase of world heritage“ with unique and original finds. 15,000 years of „Living on the Lake“ is a modern production, which is elaborately designed and themed.



In the outdoor area you can marvel at authentically reconstructed and accessible living worlds: From the Palaeolithic camp of the early Ice Age hunters, the tour takes you through the pile dwellings of the Stone Age and Bronze Age to the fishing grounds of the early Celtic period.



Tip „Archaeology live!“ Regular guided tours on prehistoric crafts, archaeological workshops, research and theme days, make learning fun.
